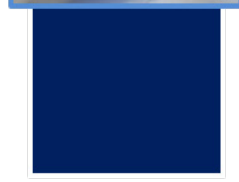
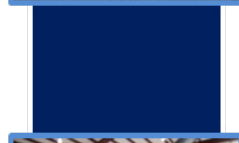
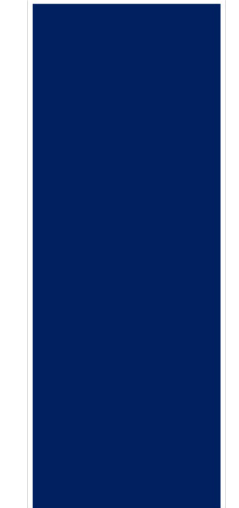
### SafetyPro™ Ground Safety Certification, OSHA Health and Safety (23 Lessons)

It is designed to be used over a 12 month period with Ramp Operational Safety as the core course. By providing your employees with the federally required training necessary for a safe working environment, accidents and injuries are reduced or eliminated, productivity and morale are increased.
